## **Brighton Optimist Club – Junior Golf Qualifier Rules**

The qualifier is stroke play. Players in each group will be given a score card, but will hand it to the player on their left before the start of play. Strokes are recorded at the end of each hole. In case of discrepancy, players should note the hole and incident and bring it to the attention of the Course Marshall as soon as practical, but before turning in score cards at the end of play.

At the end of 9 holes, golfers may take a few moments for the provided lunch. They can also tally their first 9 hole score and turn that number in for posting. At the end of the qualifier, golfers should add and compare scores, correct any arithmetic errors, sign the score they were keeping as well as counter-sign their own card before turning them in. Cards must be signed, counter-signed and turned in to be counted.

Disqualification can arise from cheating on score, foul language or unsportsmanlike conduct. The Junior Golf Chairperson and Golf Course Pro will be the sole judges of disqualification. Per Optimist International rules, college students are not eligible to play.

### **Spectator Code of Conduct**

Spectator rules will be in effect for all non-participants. Carts are not available to spectators (no exceptions). The Optimist Junior Golf Committee requires all spectators to adhere to a set of guidelines to allow Optimist Junior Golf players to compete on a level playing field with other competitors. It will also promote the game of golf and help our players grow and mature by understanding and accepting the consequences of their actions. The Spectator Code of Conduct will be in effect during all tournament rounds.

- Remain a minimum of 50 feet from all participants while following play.
- No advice is to be given to any player. A violation of this rule may result in stroke penalties or disqualification of the player.
- Help spot golf balls, but do not walk in the fairways.
- Allow rules officials to administer rulings. You will be brought into a situation only when a rules official asks.
- When on the course, turn off cell phones or turn ringers to the silent or vibrate mode.

All golfers that qualify by the criteria below may enter the Michigan District Tournament for a chance to advance to the Optimist International Junior Golf Tournament. The Brighton Optimist Club will pay for one boy and one girl winner in each of the two age groups below, providing they make the scoring cut and that they are residents of Livingston County, MI.

Boys 16-18 = 78; Girls 16-18 = 85; Boys 14-15 = 83; Girls 14-15 = 90
